GUIDELINES

Eligibility: Any person with a "tour passport" who can show proof of motorcycle license endorsement by sending a photocopy of their license with completed passport (passenger not required to have endorsement). Only one passport per person accepted.

Couples: Couples (riding on the same motorcycle) must use separate "tour passports" to be eligible for prizes.

Completion Date: December 31, 2024 all "tour passports" and/or pictures must be post-marked by January 15, 2025.

Categories: There will be five categories for the tour; North, Central and South Point of Interest Tours, the ABCs of Indiana Tour, and the Sponsor Tour.

Tour Patches: Tour patches will be awarded to first time participants and rockers for those who previously participated.



- 1 A drawing will be held no later than the ABATE Awards Banquet in February 2025.
- 2 A total of \$1,500 cash prizes will be given away.
- 3 The TOTAL cash prize will be divided equally between the tours. \$900 will be divided between the North, Central and South Points of Interest Tours. \$300 will be awarded to the ABCs of Indiana Tour. \$300 will be awarded to the Sponsor Tour.
- 4 There are a maximum of 120 chances per passport that can be accumulated from the Tour for the drawing of the cash prizes. Participants are eligible to win all cash prizes.
- 5 Anyone accumulating all 120 chances will automatically receive a one-year ABATE of Indiana membership.
- 6 Anyone completing one Points-of-Interest Tour and the ABCs of Indiana Tour will qualify for one chance at an all-events pass for 2024. Additional chances can be earned by adding a picture of the ABATE of Indiana state office, the Indiana State Motorcycle Safety Memorial and/or Coliseum Bingo (Freedom Hall). A total of four chances can be earned for an all-events pass. There will be 14 passes given away.
- 7 If less than three participants complete either category of the tour, the money will be divided equally among those who have participated in any of the tours.

HOW THE TOUR WORKS

Think of ABATE of Indiana's "Tour Indiana" program as a statewide scavenger hunt designed to encourage people to get out and ride. If that wasn't incentive enough, you can also win cash prizes! How, you ask?

Points of Interest (POI) Participants may visit the points of interest listed in this passport. Participants may ride the North Tour (Regions 0, 1, 2, 3, 4), Central Tour (Regions 5, 6, 11, 12) or South Tour (Regions 7, 8, 9, 10, 13) separately, any combination of two, or all three. A point of interest is listed in each Region (two in Region 11). There are five points of interest in each of the North, Central and South Tours (15 total). Participants simply take a picture of their motorcycle and themselves in front of the point of interest, while displaying the cover of the tour book. Couples (riding the same motorcycle) can take a picture of each other with their motorcycle, while displaying the cover page of the tour book. Participants will qualify for 2 chances per picture to win cash prizes for each of these tours they complete.

ABCS of Indiana Participants must take a picture of their motorcycle and themselves in front of the name of a city, town or county sign using the alphabet A through Z (there is no K), while displaying the cover of the tour book. Couples (riding the same motorcycle) can take a picture of each other with their motorcycle, while displaying the cover of the tour book. A picture of five of the State Parks and/or State/National Forests is also needed. Participants will receive two chances for each letter of the alphabet, State/National Park or State/National Forest submitted. There are a total of 60 chances available for this tour.

Sponsor Tour Visit a sponsor listed on the inside back cover. Participants must take a picture of their motorcycle and themselves in front of the business signage while displaying the cover of the tour book (15 total). Participants will qualify for 2 chances per picture to win cash prizes for this tour. Only one sponsor can be submitted under the same name (i.e. "Pomp's Tire" can only be submitted one time, even though they are listed multiple times). There are currently 41 Sponsors available to choose from for this tour. BONUS, all meeting locations listed at the beginning of each region's news section in "Hoosier Motorcyclist" magazine count as additional locations.



Auburn Cord Duesenberg Automobile Museum

(GPS: N 41° 21.362 W 85° 3.427) 1600 Wayne St, Auburn, IN 46706 (260) 925-1444 Open 9 – 5 Daily

This museum opened in 1974 and is dedicated to preserving the history and cars built by Auburn Automobile, Cord Automobile, and the Duesenberg Motors Company. The museum is located in the former administration building of the Auburn Automobile Company, which operated on this property from 1900 until its closure in 1937. The building was designed by architect Alvin M. Strauss in the Art Deco style built in 1930. The Auburn Automobile Company had its genesis as a carriage manufacturer, and at its height had more than 18 acres of facilities her. After its closure, the administration building housed a bre. After its closure, the administration building housed a decontinued manufacturers, including the Auburn, Cord, and Duesenberg nameplates, until 1960.

Your best picture location is from the parking lot or street on the north side of the building at the main museum entrance.

Boy Scouts of America Liberty Statue

(GPS: N 41° 20.634 W 86° 18.658) 501 N Center St, Plymouth, IN 46563 Open 24/7

There is not much back story about this particular monument but the Boy Scouts of America were behind a program called Strengthening the Arm of Liberty. Between 1949 and 1952, approximately two hundred 8-foot tall replicas of the statue, made of stamped copper, were purchased by Boy Scout troops and donated in 39 states in the U.S. and several of its possessions and territories. The project was the brainchild of Hansas City businessman, J.P. Whitaker, who was then Scout Commissioner of the Hansas City Area Council. The copper statues were manufactured by Friedley-Voshardt Co. of Chicago, Illinois, and originally cost \$350.00, equivalent to about \$4,500 today.

The marker is on North Center Street between Jefferson Street and Madison Street. Located at the East entrance of the Marshall County Courthouse in Plymouth. If you park on Madison St, you might be able to get the "M" and PNI

Starke County Veterans Memorial Plaza

(GPS: N 41° 17.912 W 86° 37.334) 53 E Washington St, Knox, IN 46534 Open 24/7

Dedicated on Veteran's Day in 2020, the Memorial Plaza combines the former memorials of WWII Horea & Vietnam monuments into a single location honoring all veterans past, present, and future. During the ceremony, the names of all 100 fallen soldiers from the county were read. Residents of the county raised half the funds needed for the memorial and the other half was provided by The Indiana Housing and Community Development Authority.

Located at Washington and Pearl Streets on the southeast corner of the courthouse square, you can pull right up to the curb and get your picture.

F-4c Phantom II Display

(GPS: N 40° 25.342 W 85° 38.561) 522 E 8th St, Fairmount, IN 46928 Open 24/7

We see many military tanks, artillery, and aircraft on display at VFWs across the state however this one is a little different. Tail number 63-7623 was flown by Major John Pardo and 1st Lt. Steven Wayne over Vietnam from December 1966 to July 1967. Lt. Wayne was from right here in Fairmount, class of 60. They flew one mission on May 20, 1967, that put 8 Phantoms against 16 to 22 MIG-17 fighters in two different battle areas. He was credited with two kills in the engagement; note the red star on the splitter plate. He later served as an F-106 Delta Dart instructor pilot and an instructional sustems development officer with the Air Defense Weapons Center at Tundall AFB. He finished his career as Assistant Deputy for Operations with Headquarters 9th Air Force and U.S. Central Command Air Forces

General Lew Wallace Study & Museum

[GPS: N 40° 2.422 W 86° 53.608] 200 Wallace Ave, Crawfordsville, IN 47933 [765] 362-5769 Open 10-5, Tue.-Sat.

Us old timers will probably remember this stop as it was used in 2003 & 2008 but most of you have not seen this one before. It was called the Ben-Hur Museum because General Lew Wallace wrote Ben Hur: A Tale of the Christ. But Lew Wallace was first a copyist of the Marion County Clerk and served as a 2nd Lt in the Mexican-American War. After the war, he became a lawyer and later served as state senator and Adjutant General of Indiana. He was promoted to Major General during the Civil War and is credited for leading troops in the Battle of Monocacy, which saved Washington, D.C., from a Confederate assault.

The entrance to the visitor center is located on the east side of the property on Elston Ave but there is a nice walk entrance on the west side on Wallace Ave. Both are acceptable.

Cardinal Greenway - Muncie Depot

The Cardinal Greenway is Indiana's longest span of recreational trails reaching from Richmond to points past Marion. Land was purchased in 1993 from CSH and the first trail opened in 1998. The Muncie Depot was placed on the National Registry of Historic Places in 1997 and acts as the headquarters for the Cardinal Greenway.

There is a nice parking area you can pull into for your picture and take a minute to stretch and walk around the depot.

Here is a POI you may want to plan well in advance. If you are a BTO fan, they are scheduled for June 16 this year. So, if you thought they only have country music shows, guess again. The \$12 million music venue opened in 2019 to sell out crowds. A state-of-the-art sound system and room acoustics along with lighting design create an experience that every seat in the house can enjoy. Seating 2,000 fans none of which are over 106 feet from the stage.

The center is at the end of Maple Leaf Blvd in Nashville. If coming from the east, turn left past the Hard Truth Distillery sign. From the west, turn right past the Salt Creek Inn. The sign out front is good but the real beauty is the building.

The west wall appears to have outgrown the original plan but still provides a history of the town and its residents with over 100 portraits included.

Interurban Railcar Shelter House

[GPS: N 38° 41.772 W 85° 46.431] North End of Bond St, Scottsburg, IN 47170 Open 24/7

This POI is part of the early rail travel history in Indiana. The Interurban Railcar was part of a large rail system stretching from Louisville to South Bend. This portion of the rail line was operated by the Indianapolis and Louisville Traction Company running on 1200 volts DC supplied by two 750-hp Allis-Chalmer single-cylinder Curtiss engines in the powerhouse adjacent to Lake lola. The Shelter House is located inside William H Graham Park on Bond St. which dead ends at the railcar shelter. Your best access is from Lakeshore Dr. South because part of Bond St is gravel.



The Red Mills

(GPS: N 39° 34.801 W 85° 55.346) 3823 N London Rd, Fairland, IN 46126 Open 24/7

This mill is located on London Road, a fun twisting ride along Sugar Creek north of Boggstown. The mill was a functioning grist mill from 1821 until the early 1970s. Built by Joseph Hough, the mill was powered by water flow from Sugar Creek. Originally called The Hough Mill, it was the largest grain center in the county outside of Shelbyville. Mr. Hough operated the mill and drove to Cincinnati to sell the mill's production. Later renamed Red Mill when F.R. Garver purchased the mill, it is now held in a private trust.

Uranus Indiana sells freshly made fudge in more than a dozen different flavors, including cookies and cream, peanut butter chocolate, blueberry cheesecake, rocky road, and the most amusing: The Mayor's #2 Most Favorite Fudge, which includes pieces of candy corn in it! It is located on the south side of 53rd St in Anderson and is open daily from 9 to 8.

Exotic Feline Rescue

(GPS: N 39° 23.617 W 87° 4.121) 2221 E Ashboro Rd, Center Point, IN 47840 812-835-1130 Open 10 to 4 daily

We had to wait to have this one as a POI but it is finally here. The EFRC is the second largest big cat rescue center in the United States, providing a permanent home for non-domestic cats that have been abused, abandoned, or lack habitation for other reasons. They are a 501c3 tax-exempt charitable organization with over 200 acres of land dedicated to keeping the wild in the cats. It cares for ten exotic feline species, including lions, tigers, leopards, servals, pumas, bobcats, Canada lynx, ocelots, Geoffroy's cat, and an Asian leopard cat.

There is not a lot of signage to help you locate the center. From Ashboro on SR 59 turn east onto Ashboro Rd for about 2 miles to the EFRC entrance. From SR 46 you can take Ashboro Rd for a little over 2 miles to the center but be advised, that part of this is gravel. To miss the gravel, continue up 46 to CR 300 E to Ashboro Rd, and the center will be on the right.



Wheeling Covered Bridge

[GPS: N 380 24.719 W 870 27.448] Moores Bridge Rd (390N), Patoka, IN 47666 Open 24/7

The Wheeling Covered Bridge is one of the few covered bridges we have had on the tour that we do not ride over. The bridge was built in 1877 by William Washer over the Patoka River. The builder used the Smith #4 Truss design which incorporated crisscrossing beams with a large open triangle at the bridge's center and served the community until it was closed to motorized traffic in 1976.

The bridge is just west of the intersection of 585 E & 390 N in the community of Wheeling formerly Kirksville. You will want to come in on 390 N as 585 E is gravel.
